The Oaklands Community Association has invited the City of Victoria to their April 4 meeting to present and discuss the proposed transportation projects in your community.

At the meeting projects will be presented and discussed.

- Pedestrian and cyclist connection on Doncaster Drive at Hillside Avenue
- Paving and upgrades to sidewalks along Ryan Street

The multiuse pathway connection will be installed to connect Myrtle Avenue to Hillside Avenue and Doncaster Drive. The multiuse path will serve pedestrians and cyclists and will include signal changes and a new crosswalk installation at the Hillside Avenue intersection with Doncaster Drive. The paving project along Ryan Street is planned from Asquith to Roseberry, which could also include continuing the sidewalk along the north side of the street.


