
IVY PLACE GREENWAY

REPORT SUMMARY #3 Nov 23, 2015

What's the project?

An exciting community-based project to enhance and restore the natural ecology of the Ivy Place Greenway in Oaklands.



Who's involved?

- local neighbours and community members
- Habitat Acquisition Trust (HAT)
- IslandTransformations.org (ITO)
- funding through City of Victoria Strategic Plan grant

Recent news:

- crushed rock for crossing and Cedar chips for trail delivered
- top soil delivered and spread
- Nov 22: work party
 - trail improved to accommodate wet winter conditions
 - planted new section at top of hill
 - all English Ivy essentially removed from Central Field
 - added Camas in several areas
 - 4 Garry Oak saplings planted







Next steps:

- finalize signage arrangements with City: make signs and then erect; or shift budget to more plants if City has plans for signs
- add bird house at East Entrance
- as we remove ivy, consider other names:
 Oaklands Greenway, Camas Knoll?
- should the road right-of-way be closed?
- project completed by Dec 31: finish and submit project documentation
