Report to Oaklands Community Association Board

Notes of activity

- 1. In late 2004 and early 2005, many emails and letters were sent to City Council showing strong neighbourhood support for preserving Ryan Hill and building the foundation for Ryan Greenway.
- 2. The detailed document, "1436 Ryan St. Lot Issues, values and Recommendations", introduced at the January 2005 Oakland Community Association Board meeting was sent to all City Council members.
- 3. In March, 2005, the City Council voted unanimously to reserve the lot as a "Neighbourhood Park, for the purpose of preserving the natural habitat".
- 4. "Initiation of the Ryan Greenway" project was developed and approved for \$4800 under the "Special Project Funding" grants with the City of Victoria.
- 5. The merging of Oaklands Green (formerly Holly Green) into the Ryan Greenway group is in progress following recommendations of Pat Johnston.
- 6. The overall Greenways program to be called "Greenways@Oaklands".
- 7. Ryan Green, Ryan Hill and Oaklands Green and interconnections will form the "Oaklands-Ryan Greenway Loop".
- 8. A group of volunteers installed the Oaklands Green Entranceway on September 10.
- 9. Later in September, volunteers started work on "*Initiation of the Ryan Greenway*" Special Project by removing litter and clearing invasive plant species from Ryan Hill.

Mission

To establish, encourage, develop, educate and maintain non-motorized Greenways and natural ecosystems in the Oaklands community.

Overall Action Plan

Finalize the overall "Greenways@Oaklands" program and "Oaklands-Ryan Greenway Loop".

Execute the "Initiation of the Ryan Greenway" Special Project.

Complete the merging of Oaklands Green into the overall Greenways@Oaklands program.

Investigate and apply for new funding programs relating to Greenways such as the "Neighbourhood Greenways Matching Grant" or federal infrastructure programs.
